STUD CONDITIONS



Only Icelandic mares with papers are accepted. Please enclose a copy of the pedigree certificate as well as a possibly existing breeding evaluation with the registration. The discounts listed in the price information refer to scores of FIZO-assessed mares, which can only be granted on presentation of a copy of the existing breeding assessment at the time of registration. The mares must be free of contagious diseases and come from a disease-free herd. All mares must present a bacteriological swab sample with negative results (not older than 28 days). Those mares that are covered on the field have to present a negative swab sample for CEM (not older than 90 days) as well. The CEM swab must be taken from the clitoris, which is thus also possible in pregnant mares without any problems. For mares in insemination, this is not obligatory, but recommended. The results of the swab samples must be proven by laboratory findings, freely formulated certificates are not accepted. The test report must indicate the location where the sample was taken. These hygiene conditions also apply to mares with foals at foot. In the case of illnesses and injuries for which veterinary treatment appears necessary, a veterinarian will be called in by the stallion owner at his own discretion at the expense and on behalf of the mare owner. The same applies mutatis mutandis to any necessary blacksmith work. The mares must be prepared for all-day grazing, dewormed, vaccinated, haltertrained and unprotected.

The best possible accommodation and care is provided. However, the stallion owner accepts no liability for death, damage, theft or reduced value of the mare or the associated foal, regardless of the cause. The Stud Owner shall also not be liable for any damage caused by the delivery of the mare to the stallion or by the act of mating itself. The liability of the stud shall be limited to such damages caused by gross negligence or willful misconduct on the part of the stud, any further liability shall be excluded. The exclusion of liability also includes the activities of vicarious agents and also extends to their possible intent. The mare owner shall be exclusively liable for any damage caused by his horse. He/she is responsible for ensuring that the horse is covered by a liability insurance policy covering all cases of animal owner liability and other risks. The boarding costs in the group are € 10.00 per day in the pasture (pasture covering) or in a communal paddock close to the farm (hand covering, insemination on site) and € 16.00 for accommodation in a box or in a single paddock. The latter is only possible on request. The heat cycle of the mares coming to the insemination station must be known. Eczema care or administration of medication is possible. The presentation of the mare to the vet will be charged with € 10.00 per day.

The delivered mares must be halter-trained and easy to catch, also to ensure possible eczema care or administration of medication. If a mare cannot be haltered well, the additional effort will be charged and the mare will be accommodated in a box if necessary. Pasture coverings come about when there are at least five mares.

The insemination station at the Kronshof is certified by the responsible Chamber of Agriculture of Lower Saxony and is supervised by a veterinarian in accordance with the applicable regulations. The stud fee is due once, semen shipment can be requested twice per heifer, delivery by overnight express in the morning until 8:00 a.m. (Tuesday to Saturday). Delivery on weekend (Sunday, Monday) and public holiday (resp. the following day of public holiday) is not possible. For detailed information on insemination see separate mare information. FOR STALLIONS USED FOR INSEMINATION A SHORT ABSENCE DUE TO THE TOURNAMENT IS POSSIBLE DURING THE COVERING PERIOD.

An amount defined in the respective stallion information will be charged as registration fee, which will be fully deducted from the stud fee. The amount is considered as reservation/processing fee, is



due upon registration and will also be retained in case of cancellation or non-pregnancy of the mare. Rebookings within the breeding season are possible with the following fees: Covering of another mare by the same stallion (change of mare): processing fee € 50.00, Covering of the same mare by another stallion (change of stallion): generally only possible with Kronshof-owned stallions, processing fee € 100.00. Please transfer the amount to our account. All remaining costs are to be paid in cash or by ec-cash upon collection of the mare. All prices printed for services at Kronshof include VAT.

If mares are not in foal when covered by stallions, the stud fee will be refunded. In this case, the registration fee will be retained as a processing fee. A prerequisite for the refund is the completed non-pregnancy form 2024, which must be submitted to the Kronshof no later than 6 weeks after the last insemination/covering of the mare, otherwise no non-pregnancy options are possible. Please note that pregnancy/non-pregnancy cannot be determined with certainty within the first 16 days after covering.
